

ART CLAY™ SILVER Basic Instruction Guide

Glass Marker



Winter is home party season and many of you will be entertaining at home or going to parties yourselves. With all the guests and festivities, it's hard to find your own glass. Not any more! Now you can find your glass easily with your Art Clay original glass marker.

<Material>

A-052	Art Clay Silver 650/1200 Clay Type 7g	1pc
K-006	Flat Screw Eye (small)	1pc
K-001	Round Jump Ring (small)	1pc

Completed piece

<Step by Step Guide>



- 1) Bend into an L-shape the screw part of the flat screw eye with some flat nose pliers.



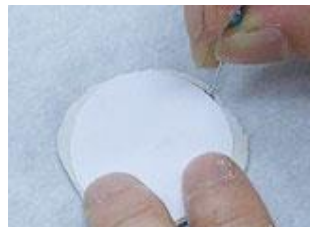
- 2) Finished shape.



- 3) Put one third of 7g of the clay into the petit mold (You can use any small molds). Remove any extra clay with a spatula (Keep the extra clay with the remaining clay in the clay pack).



- 4) Insert the flat screw eye into the top and dry.



- 5) Prepare the diameter 2.7cm design pattern. Place a pair of 1mm thick plastic strips on the both sides, roll out with a roller. Place the pattern and cut out with a needle.



- 6) Make a hole for the round jump ring with a toothpick, hang on the edge of the paper cup and dry.



- 7) Smooth the sides of the charm and circle with a medium fine file, then smooth the surface with a red sponge sanding pad (#320-600) and fire.



- 8) Polish the entire piece with a stainless steel brush and bend up the flat screw eye from the backside carefully.



- 9) Attach the charm and circle with the round jump ring and finish.
